Currently, they are home for the month of August from boarding school and college.

A couple of representatives with the Gideons visited the home in Kenya and Uganda recently. They passed out bibles to children. We are thankful they took their time out of their busy schedules.

We have just completed our third house for desperate widows and families who are unable to work due to serious illness. This construction includes concrete walls and floor, metal roof, paint, windows and secure door. The residents are so grateful and send their gratitude to all who are making their lives lighter.

We are adding gutters and water tanks in areas where there is no access to water. This allows water to be caught by the rain. Consolada, whom we built the first house for, told our Director that many times she was unable to cook. Although, she had food from our distribution, she had no water and no one to fetch it for her. She willingly shares this water with the locals.

We have added new side walks and steps going up to the children's home. A retaining wall was added as well. This provided more yard for our children to play.
